



Ways You Can Help at Of One Accord Ministry...

- **MAKE A FINANCIAL DONATION** - A \$25 contribution will help us obtain 178 pounds of food at Second Harvest Food Bank, which will feed 6 families for 10 days each.
- **DONATE USED CLOTHING** - Our two thrift stores sell quality, used clothing and other household items at bargain prices. More than 40% of the ministry's operating budget is generated sale at our thrift stores.
- **DONATE USED FURNITURE** - We sell good, used furniture at our thrift stores, with all proceeds used to support the work of the ministry.
- **VOLUNTEER YOUR TIME** – More than 300 volunteers donate their time and talents each year to help serve those in need in our community. Why not join them? If you can spare an hour or two, we could use your help. You can volunteer once a week, once a year, or for a special project.
- **SPONSOR A FOOD DRIVE OR A FUNDRAISER** – You can host a food drive at your church, work, or your child's school or sponsor a fundraising event for Of One Accord Ministry. People need food and other assistance all year long, and your help is needed to help provide basic food items, daily home cooked meals, medical care and other types of assistance to those in need.

- **BUY ONE/GIVE ONE** - When grocery stores have a buy one, get one free sale, why not donate the free items to one of our food pantries?
- **VOLUNTEER AT OUR FREE CLINIC** - Medical providers, nurses (RN's or LPN's), office workers, Hispanic interpreters, and cleaning people are always needed at our free medical clinic in Church Hill.
- **HAVE AN EXTRA WINTER COAT?** - Each year we provide free used warm coats to children and adults during the winter months. Through consistent, annual donations, we have distributed 10,260 winter coats since 1989 to those in need.
- **SPONSOR A CHILD AT CHRISTMAS** - Each year we make sure hundreds of children in Hawkins County do not go without Christmas gifts, parties, or the true message of Christmas. You, your church, or place of business can help make this possible by sponsoring a child or several children. Last year, we ensured over 1,000 children had a good Christmas holiday.
- **ASSIST WITH NEEDS OF AN ELDERLY PERSON** - We have a special interest in the elderly of our community. Whether it's delivering a hot meal, helping with a home repair, or just making a home visit, volunteers are needed all year long.

- **HOLIDAY MEALS** - Want to experience an extra warm feeling during the Holidays? We need help with packing and delivering food boxes at Christmas time or serving meals on Christmas Day.
