How can you become involved with NDP?

- On the Sunday before the NDP - Churches are encouraged to begin announcing community NDP events by way of bulletins and announcements.
- On the Wednesday evening before NDP - Churches are encouraged to use NDP topics for either their Bible study or evening prayer efforts.
- On Thursday, the NDP – Host a prayer event

Churches: Churches are encouraged to open their doors before work on the NDP from 7-8 a.m. Under the direction of a prayer facilitator, we ask that you have a time of prayer for **NDP topics** such as:

- Our Nation and its Leaders
- Our Schools and their Teachers and Administrators
- Our Families
- Our Churches, Pastors and Church Leaders
- The Media and its Influence in America

Schools: School children are encouraged to organize “Pray at the Flagpole” or other Prayer Observances that day.

Businesses/Industry: Industry workers are encouraged to ask for a place in a break room to pray with fellow workers during their break or on their lunch hour.

Prayer Teams: Teams are encouraged to do Prayer Walking throughout the day focusing on local places of leadership such as the local court house or city hall, emergency response groups such as the police, fire or EMS, and schools or within neighborhoods.
